SUBJECT/CONTENT AREA: Language Arts

STANDARD: 6.3.3: Analyze the influence of the setting on its problem and resolution

LESSON OBJECTIVE: Students will use the Internet and other source materials to research and explore the setting of the novel *Holes* by Louis Sachar.

MATERIALS: Holes, computers with word processing and Internet capabilities

**PROCEDURES**:

FOCUS AND REVIEW	<i>I</i> -Begin by introducing and exploring the text <i>Holes</i> and its setting of Texas.
TEACHER INPUT-	Help students to understand the differences between genres in relation to texts (fiction, realistic fiction, etc)
GUIDED PRACTICE-	Research as a class the history of Texas and the town of Green Lake that was abandoned after the Civil War.
INDEPENDENT PRACTICE- Create a blog post exploring the ways in which using both fictional and real locations for setting help further <i>Holes</i> ' plot lines.	
CLOSURE-	Share ideas drawn from posts in an Socratic Seminar

**EVALUATION:** 

STUDENT PERFORMANCE- Express understanding through blog post and ability to participate in Socratic Seminar

TEACHER PERFORMANCE- Successfulness of students 'understanding as expressed through blog posts and seminar.
